## Dowsing with Sound, Colour and Planetary Energies

John, Chair of West Wales Dowzers for many years and a dowser for even more, never fails to enthral with his extensive knowledge of a life in dowsing. As he says, he knows 'a lot about nothing' but his excellent presentation demonstrated that he knows an awful lot about everything.

He first became aware he wasn't 'normal' when, standing in a field during the war, he heard 'a full blown orchestra'. Later, he visited his Auntie in hospital where she told him she was 'ever so poorly' but something moved him to tell her not to be so silly and that she'd be home in two days – she was! This wasn't just a 'flash in the pan' but happened several times when he saw people in hospital. Subsequently he was drawn into healing which he describes as a 'privilege'.

He says during the healing process he reaches to the 'highest Universal energy' which is a 'moving and profound' experience as the healing rays come through. John believes it's important to leave out the 'I', the ego. We cannot put ourselves first but must listen to where the higher power is indicating the healing should come from: the earth, sky, cosmos, sun or moon. Always ask permission first, 'tune into' what is necessary for the betterment of the person. If a star energy is indicated, then 'pick a star', bring it into your third eye, absorb its energies and then send to your recipient.

He works with different vibrations which he picks up intuitively. Vibrations are just energy everything is energy just vibrating on a different level. We are physical beings, just matter, energy which can't be destroyed it just alters shape and form. When we pass on to spirit our physical

body changes to a different form and our bodies are returned to the ground or changed again by cremation. We become fertiliser. Re-cycled. This is the same for everything in the Universe.

John also works with the chakras, dowsing intuitively for chakras that aren't working properly. He spoke about seven chakras or main energy centres in the body (although there are many more) – the crown, third eye, throat, heart, solar plexus, sacral and root chakra. Each chakra is associated with a colour but John says these colours can change and sometimes more or less is needed dependent upon the environment or health of the patient. Members, working in twos, were shown how to dowse each other's chakras, working intuitively to discover what colours were needed in each chakra. A fascinating exercise and rewarding for those that reported feeling better.

John also encouraged dowsing our food and drink everyday to ensure that what we are putting in our bodies was actually providing us nourishment or whether it was a 'poison'. Similarly the effects of medication could change and it was not only important to dowse our tablets but also the dose.

## Consciousness and Spirit of Landscape

What a cornucopia of dowzers and what a surprise for members and Committee alike! It was Patrick's idea to bring other members of his Geomancy group to supplement his presentation with their own thoughts. Geomancy is the art of balancing, clearing and transforming detrimental energies in a home or landscape.

Patrick kicked off his talk by outlining his impressive history, Past President of the British Society of Dowzing and twenty years as a

professional dowser working worldwide. He believes that most of the problems he's called to troubleshoot are caused by 'Water' especially the presence of underground streams. Referring to a German study in 1928 undertaken by a doctor who studied all the bed positions of a town's population, it was discovered that 52 cases of cancer were sleeping over underground streams.

Water that is seeking to find a way to the surface has tremendous power becoming either a swirling blind spring or domes. Fonts and altars were mostly found over blind springs probably due to the fact that churches had been built over original pagan sites and standing stones were most often erected over domes demonstrating that our ancestors were well aware of the power of such earthly phenomena.

Unfortunately though, most domestic animals (apart from cats – typical!) find that these energies to be quite debilitating. Naturally they would avoid them but on a farm this is not always possible. Problems with cows and diseases of the udder are often due to cow sheds being sited over blind springs. Once Patrick advises the owner

to move them, the problems often spontaneously disappear.

Patrick also dowses for wells and drew members into his description of his 'thumping heart' whilst he waited for drills to confirm his findings and the relief when they did. He once dowsed a well saying it would give 16 gallons per minute, only to be informed by the ecstatic owner that it in fact was giving 100! He also believes that water has a 'consciousness', outlining the Japanese scientist, Dr. Matsuro Emoto's work which proved this.

Briefly, Dr. Emoto affixed labels to bottles of water, saying 'I hate you' or 'I love you' and found that those with negative labels formed jagged crystals whereas the positive ones formed beautiful crystalline shapes. He also played raucous rock music to some and classical music to others with similar results. As a large percentage of the human body is water, it makes you think what might be the crystal shapes in our own bodies and how this might affect our health. He advised us to bless our food and drink because this would be pleasing and be better for us.

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Believing that everything has a consciousness, Patrick is very careful to perform ceremonies before dowsing to ask permission from the 'water divas' and to bless the water he finds. He was amazed to witness sheep on a farm in Australia, stampeding towards a natural spring that had been subjected to his ceremonies as opposed to other water that hadn't. This similar to the 'dressing and blessing' of wells that is still performed today.

Jon Appleton (Goddess in the Sky): Emphasised the importance of 'tuning into the spirit of the place' and to talking to standing stones, listening for expressions of happiness or sadness. Learn how to 'listen and turn off our left brain'.

Sig Lonegren: Is now concentrating less on actual physical dowsing, archaeoastronomy and even sacred geometry, he is now working even more with a spiritual approach. Dowsing was first called 'Divining' which is much closer to its sacred roots. Gnosis or 'Knowledge' of the sacred was the original 'religion' but was later usurped by organised religions.

Knowledge was only passed on to those that had shown they were ready, usually after many years of study in mystery schools. Dowzers are 'gnostics' and our aim should be to use our intuition more. A way to stimulate this was to practise, practise, practise with our pendulums.

Shaun Kirwan – <http://www.georepairman.co.uk>: Shaun is able to draw on his extensive background to complement his Geomancy training, including Shamanism and Buddhism. This has led to him developing his intuitive skills for Earth Healing, and creating sacred space.

He is a natural psychic and dowser and designer of Sacred Sites & Stone Circles with a natural affinity to Nature Spirits and Elementals. He works with them to bring healing and harmony to places and landscapes. He is also actively involved in researching energy grids and other geomantic features and Ley alignments. He has been teaching dowsing and working with earth energies since 2001.


**Sig:** It's not the water per se but the way it's flowing.
